Magnolia comes standard including the patented SPGPrints Archer+Pro technology. This automated nozzle correction software ensures perfect positioning of each drop on the fabric. The automatic individual nozzle correction ensures always a perfect image quality without striping. The automated and therefore operator independent bi-directional alignment allows to print almost all design in bi-directional mode, enabling a higher yield of printed meters per hour without the so-called 'Soccerfield effect'. Finally, it extends the lifetime of all printheads thanks to nozzle compensation for misaligned or missing nozzles.
